Chronological order

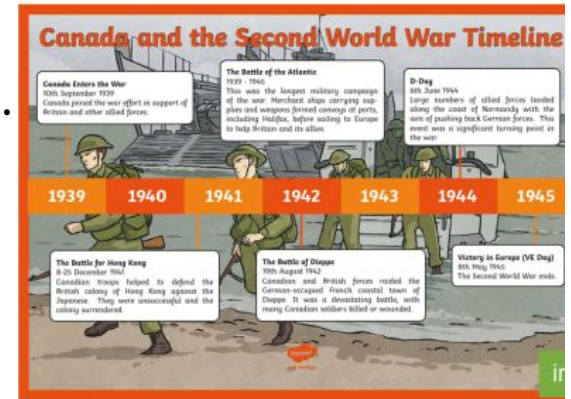
In History we use chronological order to organise dates and events.

This means that we put events in order of when they happened. We typically do this on a timeline and put events in order from the earliest to the latest date.

On the next slide you will see some Kings and Queens.

Can you put these monarchs into chronological order?



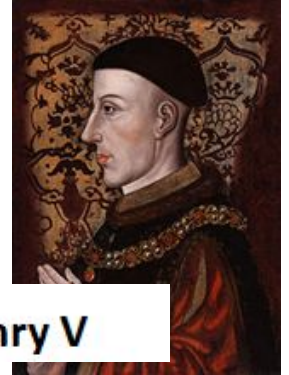

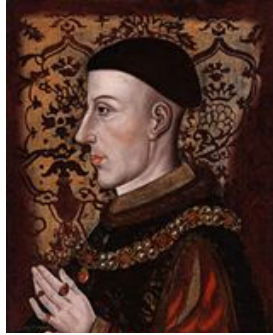

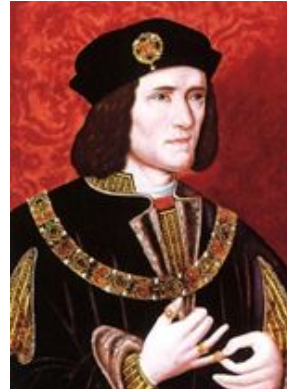
